Establishment of working center "Open door for inclusive support" in premises of partner school licenced for functional adults education, where beneficiaries will be informed, encouraged and supported through three types of programmes i.e. Informative and Educational Support Programme, Health care Improvement in coopreation with Health Centre, and Pedagogical and Psychological Support Programme.

Together through Knowledge

Establishment of a learning support service within the partner school intended for Roma children through mentoring assistance, workshops, provision of school supplies and socio-educative support to their parents. The service will be provided within the partner school three times a week for four hours per day during eight months which will contribute to increase the school enrollment rates of Roma children, improve the average grades of Roma students, reduce the number of school drop-outs of Roma students, and develop a positive attitude towards education in Roma community.

Comprehensive support for better access to various public services (health and social protection) with the focus on employment through workshops on active job searching and strengthening employability, including communication skills, as well as vocational training for in-demand occupations. Moreover, the most vulnerable families will be provided with basic household appliances and furniture to improve their living conditions. Finally, one of the project results will be recommendations for better systemic solutions for addressing rights and needs of informal waste pickers.

Sustainable Inclusion

The service envisages two components i.e. better employability through certified vocational training for in-demand occupations and connection with employers for practical experience/employment as well as set of social inclusion services through pedagogical support to children, educational support to adults and collaboration with healthcare institutions to ensure access to primary and specialist care. The support will be provided to ten families of informal waste pickers at the CSW registry.

Integrated Support for Vulnerable Groups in Prokuplje

Expanding the existing Day Care Centre to include older persons and individuals with disabilities, with enriched therapeutic programmes, including psychological support for families, as well as social and recreational activities.
